For the 2024 show, we continued to use social media: Instagram, Facebook with announcements through the Hill Country Mile, Visit Boerne and Boerne Chamber of Commerce accounts. Print media included posters throughout the Hill Country Mile and advertisement in Hill Country Car Culture magazine. The magazine's reach focuses on central Texas' Hill Country and beyond as it is a subscription for enthusiasts. Volunteers & members continued efforts to attend car shows in Central Texas to hand out postcards announcing the event.

Total Number of Room Nights: (Number of rooms X Number of nights): Leading up to the show through internet searches of available hotel rooms and commentary from participants, there were limited to no options available for booking during the show weekend. We believe most of these rooms were filled by attendees or spectators given this was the main event during the 10/11 to 10/13 weekend, outside of the already established Market Days. Most visitors stayed 2 nights while some decided to stay through the 3 day weekend. Calculations are based on the following: 325 rooms at 2 nights (650 total) with average of \$250 average nightly rate. This is based on assumption that the popular Fri/Sat evening rates were charged higher. 50 bookings for 3 nights (150 total) averaging a slightly lower average rate when the less popular Sunday night is included or \$225 avg nightly rate.




