STAFF’S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)	<p>Staff recommends changes to the Reclaimed (Reuse) Water Rates</p>

SUMMARY	<p>The Reclaimed (Reuse) Water Rate Ordinance was adopted in September 2015. At the time we were looking at only Residential use of reclaimed water. Esperanza has applied for a meter at the entrance to their development, and have installed a 1½” meter which was not included in the original Ordinance. We are proposing to include the 1 ½” and 2” meters at a rate of \$35 and \$55, respectively, for inside City limits.</p> <p>In addition to that change, TCEQ has determined that the appropriate terminology to use is ‘Reclaimed’ rather than ‘Reuse’ Water. Therefore, we are proposing to change the word ‘Reuse’ in the ordinance to ‘Reclaimed’.</p>
