SUMMARY	<p>Since the deadline to file for a place on the General Election ballot lapsed on February 14, 2020 and there was no opposition for Districts 1 and 5, the City can cancel the election for these two districts.</p> <p>When cancelling an election, State statute requires that the City Secretary certify the candidates unopposed. The City Council may hold the election regardless of the unopposed status of the candidates.</p>
