Background Information	The City's agreement with GBRA requires an annual declaration of our water commitment by year-end. This ensures the allocation of treated water from the Western Canyon Regional Water Supply Project to meet the City's needs. Maintaining the current 2,125 AF commitment ensures coverage for basic household and commercial needs while peak demands are met through supplementary resources. Staff recommends City Council approval to maintain the 2025 annual water commitment of 2,125 acre-feet.
