DESCRIPTION	CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R43; A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS CONSENTING TO THE ANNEXATION OF 11.785 ACRES OF LAND INTO KENDALL COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2A.
STAFF'S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)	Approve Resolution No. 2020-R43; consenting to the annexation of 11.785 acres of land into Kendall County Water Control and Improvement District No. 2A.

SUMMARY	As discussed in the previous Agenda Item, this is the adjustment of KCWCID No. 2A boundary line to include an additional 11.785 acres into KCWCID No. 2A. (See Attachment 1 for applicant commentary as well as the Petition for Consent). The annexation of the 11.785 acres into WCID 2A (and the corresponding exclusion of same acreage for WCID 2) is a simple adjustment of the Districts' boundaries to include all of the land/lots in Phase 2F within WCID 2A. Without such adjustment, some of the lots would be in WCID 2A and some would be in WCID 2. Pursuant to Chapter 42.0425 of the Texas Local Government Code, as amended, no land within the corporate limits of a city or within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a city, shall be included within a water control and improvement district unless such city grants it written consent, by resolution or ordinance, to the inclusion of land within the district.
