A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS TO HONOR, RECOGNIZE AND RETIRE CITY OF BOERNE K9 "EMMA" UPON HER COMPLETION OF SERVICE

WHEREAS, K9 "Emma" began her career with the City of Boerne Police Department in April 2019 and has rendered five years of faithful and dedicated service to the City of Boerne with direction from her handler, Detective Goudreau; and

WHEREAS, K9 "Emma" underwent specialized training at an early age and was awarded certification in narcotics detection, tracking, and criminal apprehension; and

WHEREAS, K9 "Emma" has represented her profession with pride, by participating in numerous community events, including National Night Out, BISD school events, and various demonstrations throughout the city; and

WHEREAS, K9 "Emma" has served with distinction, contributing to 172 deployments, 7 patrol apprehensions, 125 narcotics arrests, including the seizure of 123.9 kilos of Marijuana/THC, 2 kilos of methamphetamine, 6 kilos of cocaine, and \$184,143 in U.S. currency; and

WHEREAS, K9 "Emma" will be retired to serve as a permanent family member to her handler, Detective Goudreau and his family; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS:

that K9 "Emma" is hereby retired from active service with the Boerne Police Department, and the City Council authorizes the transfer of care and custody of K9 "Emma" to Detective Goudreau.
