Background Information	The applicant is Boerne Dental Center located at 32350 IH10. The applicant is requesting a variance to UDC Section 3.17.E, Scenic Interstate Corridor Overlay District, Medium Elevation Area Sign Dimensions to allow for installation of a new 45 ft. tall 6′ x 8′ internally illuminated pole mounted sign. The applicant states that they are looking to grow their new dental buisness and potential customers do not realize the location is a dental practice. The applicant states the onsite trees are 30′-35′ tall and to clear the trees and have unobstructed visibility the sign needs to be 45′ tall. Currently, there is an existing free standing monument sign located at the site along the IH10 access road.		
	The property is in the Medium Elevation Zone of the Interstate Corridor Overlay District. The variance request is in consideration of the follow UDC requirements:		
	Section 3.17.E Scenic Interstate Corridor District Overlay. Medium Elevation Area:		
	 Pole signs shall not exceed 30 feet in height without a Certificate of Approval from the Design Review Committee (DRC). The maximum height for any pole sign in the Medium Elevation Area is 40 feet. The sign area shall not exceed 40 square feet per sign face. 		
	The proposed sign is not compliant for the following reasons:		
	 The proposed sign area exceeds 40 sq. ft. per sign face, The proposed sign height exceeds 30 feet, which is the maximum allowed in the medium elevation area without a Certificate of Approval from the Design Review Committee (DRC). The DRC can grant an exception for up to 40 feet in height. 		

	The purpose of the Scenic Interstate Corridor Overlay District is to preserve the natural landscape and the scenic hill country views that characterize IH-10 as it passes through the Balcones Escarpment and into the Edwards Plateau Ecoregion by minimizing the visual and environmental impact of auto-oriented development on the natural landscape.


