Background Information	The Parks and Recreation Department has traditionally been responsible for the installation and maintenance of Christmas lights throughout the city. While this has created a festive atmosphere appreciated by residents and visitors alike, it has placed significant strain on the department's resources, diverting staff time from other essential tasks and projects. To ensure an improved holiday experience and relieve the Parks Department of this time-intensive responsibility, staff budgeted for a professional service agreement to install, maintain, remove, and store Christmas lights in the FY 2024-2025 budget.			
	 Enhance the holiday experience for residents and visitors with high-quality, professionally installed lighting. Include additional decorative details in response to increased holiday tourism, such as wrapping the trees at Main Plaza to their very tops, adding more decorations along Main Street and City Hall, and bringing back the Christmas trees at Heart of Boerne. Reduce the workload and safety impacts on the Parks and Recreation staff, allowing them to focus on other critical projects and maintenance tasks during the holiday season. Ensure timely installation and removal, maintaining the aesthetic appeal of the city and preventing potential delays. Align with our mission to deliver exceptional community services and create memorable public experiences. 			
	Financial Impact : The total cost for the contracted service is \$60,723 and this was an approved FY25 budget item. This funding amount includes the professional installation, maintenance, and removal of			

	Christmas lights throughout key city locations to enhance the city's holiday display and support the Parks and Recreation Department's operational efficiency. This purchase will be made through BuyBoard, ensuring competitive pricing and efficiency. Staff recommends Council approval of the resolution to allow the City Manager to execute and administer the lease agreement between the City of Boerne and Décor IQ.
