

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND MANAGE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOERNE AND INTERMOUNTAIN SLURRY SEAL, INC. FOR THE 2026 STREET PRESERVATION (SLURRY SEAL) PROJECT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$196,994

WHEREAS, slurry sealing (or micro-surfing) is part of the City's 10-year street maintenance plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boerne is utilizing the cooperative purchasing program through TIPS to procure the 2026 Street Preservation (Slurry Seal) Project; and

WHEREAS, Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive proposal through the TIPS cooperative purchasing program in the amount of \$187,612.99; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to authorize the City Manager to execute and manage a contract with Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc., including a five percent (5%) contingency for unforeseen field conditions, for an amount not to exceed \$196,994;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein and made part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into and manage a contract with Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc., through the TIPS cooperative purchasing program, in the base contract amount of \$187,612.99, together with a five percent (5%) contingency for unforeseen field conditions, for a total authorized amount not to exceed \$196,994.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to manage and execute the related contract and documents thereto on behalf of the City of Boerne, Texas.
