A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE ALAMO AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT AND TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES CALL FOR PROJECTS FOR THE FY 2027-2030 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP).

WHEREAS, the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) has issued a call for Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) and Transportation Alternatives (TA) funded projects for the FY 2027-2030 Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) has provided the City of Boerne the opportunity to submit and support transportation improvement projects within Boerne; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boerne will submit and be the sponsoring agency for transportation improvement projects in the city for consideration for the 2027-2030 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS:

THAT, the City of Boerne supports the city projects indicated in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto; and

THAT, the City of Boerne commits to fund a minimum local cash match of 20% of the total project cost for any city submitted project that is selected by the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) to be included in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

THAT, the City of Boerne understands and acknowledges that all awarded funding is provided on a reimbursement basis; and

THAT, the City of Boerne supports the Texas Department of Transportation submitted projects in the Boerne area, including their proposed turn lane improvements at the River Road (SH46) and Herff intersection; and

THAT, the City hereby authorizes and directs Ben Thatcher, City Manager, or designees to sign the application and act on the City's behalf in all matters pertaining to this application.

City of Boerne Transportation Improvement Projects for the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization FY 2027-2030 Transportation Improvement Program

Priority	Project Name	Description
Transportation Alternatives		
1	Citywide sidewalk projects	Construct concrete sidewalk along portions of Bentwood Drive, Frey Street, Herff Road, Garden Street, City Park Road, Schweppe Street, W. Hosack Street, and W. Theissen Street. In addition, construct an approximate 500-foot extension of the No. 9 shared- use path north of Garden Street.
Surface Transportation Block Grant		
2	Cascade Cavern	The project is a modification of the previously selected MPO project that expands portions of Cascade Cavern, Old San Antonio, and Scenic Loop roadways and improves intersections to improve traffic flow and safety.
3	Old San Antonio Road	The project includes improvements for the intersection of Herff Road and Old San Antonio Road. Project will include new turn lanes for the intersection as described in Boerne's Mobility Master Plan as well as Menger Creek bridge and drainage improvements such that the intersection and Old San Antonio travel roadway is removed from the 100-year floodplain.
