Requested Action	APPROVE RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R22; A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND MANAGE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOERNE AND CITY OF CASTROVILLE TO ALLOW THE SHARING AND USE OF COMPETITIVELY PROCURED CONTRACTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 791 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE.

Background Information	<p>The proposed Interlocal Agreement between the City of Boerne and the City of Castroville would allow each city to use competitively awarded contracts from the other, in accordance with Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code (Interlocal Cooperation Act).</p> <p>The City of Castroville recently approached the City about potentially using one of Boerne’s existing competitively bid contracts. To share that contract in compliance with state law, this Interlocal Agreement is required.</p> <p>At this time, the City of Boerne has no plans to use any contracts awarded by the City of Castroville. However, the agreement is structured to allow reciprocal use of contracts should a future need arise, provided that the contract was procured in accordance with state law and City purchasing requirements.</p> <p>This agreement provides an administrative tool that allows the City to “piggyback” on existing contracts that have already been publicly bid and awarded in accordance with state purchasing requirements. The agreement does not obligate either City to make purchases or commit funding. Any future use of a shared contract would remain subject to City purchasing policies and to City Council budget approval, as applicable.</p> <p>Participating in this interlocal arrangement can enhance operational efficiency by reducing duplicate procurement efforts, accelerating project delivery timelines, and potentially lowering costs through cooperative purchasing. This strategy aligns with the 2018 Master</p>

	<p>Plan’s focus on sound fiscal management, efficient resource use, and collaboration with external partners to deliver municipal services effectively.</p> <p>Approval of this item authorizes the City Manager to sign the Interlocal Agreement.</p>
