Each taxing entity in Kendall County may nominate candidates to serve on this board for a two (2) year term beginning in January. This would be Mr. Weller's first term on this board. I received a ballot from the Appraisal District; see attached letter. It's been customary for the City to cast all of its 523 votes for our candidate. The number of votes are determined by the number of parcels within each taxing entities boarder.
