| Background Information | Street patching is proposed as part of the City's rolling 10-year street maintenance plan. Streets patches will be completed in areas identified by staff where pavement repair is needed based upon Pavement Condition Index (PCI) values. Because the construction cost of the project was estimated to be greater than \$50,000, State Law prescribes procurement be done under a competitive bidding process. The project bid on March 7, and we received four (4) bids ranging from \$137,756.98 to \$178,712.28. The low bid was submitted by Bueno Pro Services, LLC in the amount of \$137,756.98. A line item within the bid included a mathematic error which reduced the contract amount by \$6,000. The contractor confirmed they will honor the bid at the lower price. City staff reviewed the bids, checked references, and recommends Council receive the bids and award the construction contract to Bueno Pro Services, LLC. |
