DESCRIPTION	Discussion On Effectiveness Of Ordinance 2015-38 Amending Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles And Traffic And Allowing The Operation Of Golf Carts In The City On Certain Public Streets During The Holiday Season.

SUMMARY	<p>During the meeting on November 10, 2015, City Council approved an Ordinance allowing Golf Cart deliveries of packages during the Holiday Season (defined as 11/15 through 1/5). We decided, at this time, we would come back to City Council and discuss the effectiveness of the Ordinance and whether the Council wished to continue with the Holiday Season golf cart deliveries.</p> <p>As a reminder, the Ordinance permits the usage of Golf Carts only for deliveries and only on Public Highways within the City limits that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) have a posted speed limit of not more than 35 mph and are within a residential area; (2) do not cross (nor may the Golf Carts be driven on) state designated highways (including but not limited to, IH 10 and its frontage roads, U.S. 87, S.H. 46, F.M. 474 and 1376) or the following city roads: Adler Road, Esser Rd Herff Road, Johns Road, Old San Antonio Road, Ranger Creek Road, School Street, and Upper Balcones Road (plus we added to this list); and (3) during daytime hours (delineated as 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. to minimize disruption with school and work traffic). <p>Golf Carts must be equipped with the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Headlamps; (2) Tail lamps; (3) Reflectors; (4) Parking brake; (5) Mirrors; (6) Safety belts; and (7) An emblem for the which the Golf Cart is operating; and

	<p>(8) A slow-moving vehicle emblem.</p> <p>The Golf Cart operator must have the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) a valid driver's license; (2) employment by an entity whose primary business is the delivery of parcels; and (3) valid insurance. <p>Per Chief Kohler, there have been no complaints with the Golf Carts. Additionally, Chief Kohler was provided with a list of areas that the Golf Cart deliveries were being made.</p> <p>Does the City Council wish to continue the Golf Cart delivery during the holiday season only?</p>
