SUMMARY	<p>At the September 22, 2015 Council meeting I presented the Fiscal Year 2016 Economic Development Work Plan and requested feedback. We have made a few modifications based on the comments made at the Council meeting and other suggestions received. The revised version of the Work Plan is attached with modifications to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The listing of Key Partners • An action item regarding focus on home diversity to accommodate a wide range of needs including new workforce • An action item for ROI based analysis of potential conference center concepts • CVB to include coordinated efforts with Tapatio Springs <p>This is the fourth formal plan developed by the city in conjunction with the annual budget. This plan is the first to contain joint goals of both the City and Boerne Kendall County Economic Development Corporation (BKCEDC). It is my belief that working in conjunction with the BKCEDC, as well as the Chamber, Kendall County, BISD and other community partners we will have another productive year.</p> <p>Our overarching goal remains to seek balance between quality economic development, enhancement of Boerne's quality of life, good stewardship of natural resources, and maintaining our unique identity.</p> <p>We will seek approval of the Work Plan at the Council meeting on the 13th with implementation beginning immediately after.</p>
