Background Information	The street department budget for the current fiscal year included the 1 st annual payment for an "Asphalt Zipper" piece of equipment. Using our existing banking relationship with Frost Bank, City staff was able to negotiate a 4-year lease/purchase agreement with Frost Bank based upon the capital cost of \$246,670, for a total financed amount of \$264,424 to be paid as follows: $1^{st} year = \$66,406.00$ $2^{nd} year = \$66,006.00$ $3^{rd} year = \$66,006.00$ This new 480xi Asphalt Zipper and custom trailer for the equipment will be used by the street department crews to repair portions of existing city streets that previously would require private contractors to perform the work. This allows cost savings to the public and allows flexibility in scheduling street repairs by work being performed internally.
