Background Information	Each year, the City of Boerne contracts to provide funds with certain non-profit entities that provide specific services to the local community. After the last fiscal years' agreements, staff looked to reassess the process by which these agreements were evaluated as well as to work to strategically align these requests for funds to specific goals and principles laid out in the documents in the Rolling Ten Year Plan as well as aligning to the City's Vision, Mission, and Values. Boerne Performing Arts' (BPA) mission is to develop and sustain an environment that supports and promotes awareness, appreciation, education, and access to all the arts in Kendall County and the Texas Hill Country. Highlights of BPA include the 'For Kids' program which allows students to experience world-class professional performing artists through student programs, master classes, preludes & interludes, and art galleries Boerne Performing Arts mission and initiatives align closely with Action 6.2.4 of the City's Master Plan, which allows for the exploration of funding alternatives to provide for a greater variety of arts initiatives, which include visual and performing arts. This also aligns with the City's Vision tenant of Unique Community Charm.
