Texas's new human trafficking prevention training **REQUIREMENT** for hotel employees formally took effect on January 1st. The new **LAW** is administered by the Texas Office of the Attorney General (OAG), and it requires all commercial lodging establishments with more than 10 rooms and the direct employees of vacation rental companies if the company manages more than 10 rooms annually train employees on recognizing human trafficking activity.

Designed for hoteliers, this training course is an hour long and plainly describes laws and concrete steps on how frontline staff can personally make a difference in the lives of children and adults who are exploited every day. Attendees will be equipped with best practices to identify, and report suspected trafficking incidents, prevent trafficking, and increase hotel safety. In addition, each attendee will learn how to protect their hotel from legal risks, security risks, and reputational risks. **Everyone will receive a certificate upon completion.**
