Background Information	The City has an existing commercial vehicle ordinance (2008-61) that specifically listed portions of four (4) streets that commercial traffic, more than two (2) tons and a total of three (3) or more axles, was not permitted to travel upon.
	Since the creation of that ordinance, the City's roadway network and traffic patterns have evolved. Staff has been receiving more frequent complaints of commercial traffic traveling along roadways that are more residential in nature.
	Staff have evaluated similar ordinances from neighboring municipalities and is proposing to modify the ordinance to only allow commercial traffic on six (6) major roadways within the city limits. In addition, staff have added exceptions for city and emergency vehicles, local destinations, detours points, and buses transporting people to and from schools.
