SUMMARY	The City of Boerne and Kendall County have held an interlocal agreement for Health Sanitarian services since 2000. The agreement details the responsibilities of the County to perform inspection services for all establishments or vendors that serve or provide food to the public. Our fees last year for the services amount to \$39,082. In 2015 the County added an employee to keep up with the number of locations that required inspection. We have an increase in the number of food establishments, day care centers, foster homes, and mobile units to warrant the additional employee. The County this year is requesting an Assistant Sanitarian, fully licensed to conduct inspections. This increased our fees for service to \$49,132.00. This accounts for the new Assistant Sanitarian, as well as an increase for the Sanitarian if approved by Commissioner's Court. Kendall County is reviewing fees for inspection services, for 2017. These fees are used to offset the cost to the City. Should the fees be approved they will go into effect October, 2016. Our cost is based on the assumption the fees will be approved.
