SUMMARY	A presentation by staff will be made regarding the variety of Hill Country Mile (HCM) marketing, advertising and promotion activities completed for the months of January through July 2016. In addition to these activities, an update will be given regarding the status of completed and pending Historic District Restoration Program (HDRP) grants for properties located with the Historic District. This matching grant program began in 2013 and is a cost reimbursement program for 1:1 matching funds up to a maximum of \$5,000 for improvements to building façade, roof or foundation. Proposed improvements and program applications must be approved by the Historic Landmark Commission. Funding for this program comes from the City's economic development fund. Staff is currently reviewing the current maximum level of matching funds to see if a graduated scale of matching funds may be more beneficial, especially for larger renovation and restoration projects.
