<b>SUMMARY</b>	<p>Following the original conceptual drawing and three meetings with the Ad Hoc Committee for the Proposed City Hall Project, Randall Scott Architects (RSA) has been asked to provide us three different renditions of a proposed building for City Hall.</p> <p>For many years the City Council has looked at City Hall and struggled with the necessary expansion. The issue of a new building and the flow of the work process for the city services provided is not a new issue. Since 1993, the City Council has authorized 4 needs assessments, 5 renovations to increase office space, and added 4 portables for new space, as well as the construction of new space for the Police Department, Municipal Court and Council Chambers.</p> <p>The renditions requested by the City Council includes modifications to the original conceptual design presented by RSA in April, 2016, plus a rendition of the structure with a rotation of the Council Chambers from the main proposed structure, and a two story building with approximately the same size square footage.</p> <p>These renditions will be also presented to the public at two Public Forums, one on August 24<sup>rd</sup> at 9–11 AM at Morningside Ministries at Menger Springs in the Grand Room, and at the Patrick Health Public Library Community Room on September 1, between 5 and 7 PM.</p>
