TXDOT requires a resolution from the City of Boerne as part of the road closure procedure for events such as the annual Rod Run event scheduled for October 8 <sup>th</sup> – 9 <sup>th</sup> , 2016.
	Rod Run Event:
	Main Street will be closed from Blanco Road to James Street. James Street to River Road will be open to local traffic only. The streets and area around the plaza will also be closed to vehicular traffic. All streets that intersect into Main Street between Blanco Road and James Street will also be closed at the intersecting point at Main Street. Rosewood Avenue will be open to local traffic only via South Plant. The Detour Route will be South Main Street to River Road, River Road to Esser, Esser to Blanco and Blanco to Main Street.
	During the event there will be barricades blocking the closed roadways, signage outlining the detour route, as well as uniformed officers to direct traffic and provide event security. As

	soon as the event is over the barricades and signage will be removed from the roadway.

SOURCE OF FUNDS	Overtime police budget & funds from the Rod Run organization
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	This group partially pays for the police officers during the event and COB pays for a portion and the cost is dependent on which officer(s) actually work the event.
