Strategic Plan – FY2017 Update

In the spring of 2016, we began gathering input on library services to use in updating our existing three-year strategic plan (ended June 2016).

Three priorities were indicated:

- 1) Reading, listening and viewing for pleasure
- 2) Lifelong learning
- 3) Providing a comfortable, quiet space

We also learned that our services, facility and staff are well-appreciated. The one consistent complaint was the amount of noise in the library during after school hours. The updated plan seeks to address this issue by reconfiguring existing library space

The final plan was shared with library boards and support groups during September.
