DESCRIPTION	CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2016-R110; A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND MANAGE A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH APPLE. <i>(For iPads)</i>

SUMMARY	<p>A little over two years ago the City leased 20 iPads from Apple for various departments. We found that leasing from Apple, they discount the equipment 20%, lowering the cost versus an outright purchase by approximately \$118.42 per device. We are also able to spread the cost over two budget cycles. Another big advantage of leasing is we have the most up-to date technology in place and gives us a consistent cycle for replacement of iPads.</p> <p>In November, the contractual two-year term of the current lease will end. We find it necessary to renew the lease replacing the original 20 iPads and adding 8 new iPads for staff in Public Safety and Administration.</p> <p><u>The breakdown is as follows:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 15 Police replacements (end of lease on current) 5 Administration Replacements (end of lease) 4 New for Police (using 3 to 4-year-old purchased lpad) 4 New for Admin (using 3 to 4-year-old purchased lpad) <p>We are relying more on iPads in the field in order to better handle workflow and daily tasks that are outside of the office. Leasing iPads is much more cost effective in that when leasing we generally get a 20% discount on the equipment. Cost savings are also realized by not having to print paperwork, saving cost associated with printers and paper. The price also includes AppleCare+ on the device to cover if it is damaged or</p>

	<p>lost during the two year leasing period.</p> <p>It really is extraordinary to look at what all the iPad has replaced with the Police Department in the last few years. Not only has it replaced the \$4500.00 laptop in each patrol car, but it has replaced the need for audio recorders, digital cameras and soon will be replacing the \$2500.00 ticket writers we use now for issuing citations.</p>
