	Staff has been working since last summer with County Commissioner Carpenter and subsequently Commissioner Durden, as well as Council Member Joe Anzollitto to address roadway congestion issues during heavy traffic days at City Lake Park. There have been a number of complaints filed with both the City and the County on busy days like July 4 th and even on days where other activities at Random and Bella Springs Ranch cause the roadway to be congested and more specifically impede local traffic on Upper Cibolo Creek Road. Danny Zincke, Parks Director, estimates that there are significant issues approximately 10 days during the Summer peak period. City staff presented a concept to design a two lane roadway (see attached) for vehicle queuing on the City owned park land which would allow approximately 72 vehicles to exit the main lanes on Upper Cibolo Creek Road. Attached is a graphic showing in green the length of Upper Cibolo Creek Road which the queuing space would accommodate on the two new City Park lanes. Since then we have been working with the County to arrive at an amicable method to construct and fund the new Park roadway. The City Attorney and County Attorney are very close to having an Interlocal Agreement describing the construction process and responsibilities for payment which basically entails the County Road and Bridge crew constructing the roadway to City specifications and for actual costs to be shared once the project is completed. The estimation is that the project will cost approximately \$140K in total and that each entity will pay 50% of the actual cost.

	On Monday, March 13, 2017, Commissioner's Court will be considering the Interlocal Agreement at their meeting and if both entities approve the Agreement next week, we expect that construction will begin immediately in an attempt to have the roadway complete prior to the Memorial Day weekend beginning Friday May 26, 2017.
