<b>STAFF’S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)</b>	Approve Resolution No. 2017-R25; A Resolution Authorizing The City Manager To Proceed With Purchases As Per Section 6.08 Of The City Of Boerne’s Home Rule Charter Not To Exceed \$20,000.00. <i>(Painting by Jay Hester)</i>

<b>SUMMARY</b>	<p>Dr. Ferdinand Herff, one of the original Boerne colonists and civic leaders, was a successful doctor in this area in the late 1800’s, performing many of the United States’ medical “firsts”. In addition to battlefield surgeries, he performed surgical procedures on American Indians, Texas Rangers and Mexican dignitaries, to name a few.</p> <p>Local artist, Jay Hester, has completed a painting depicting Dr. Herff conducting cataract surgery on an American Indian. The painting, aptly entitled “The Healer”, portrays the primitive conditions that were faced at that time.</p> <p>The cost of the painting is \$20,000 and commitments have been received from local contributors for \$15,000 of the purchase price. The remaining \$5,000 would be paid by the City of Boerne.</p> <p>The contributors that have already committed to the purchase are as follows.          \$5,000 – Patrick and Carla Heath          \$5,000 – Majestic Ranch Arts Foundation          \$5,000 – Anonymous Donor</p> <p>Each contributor would make payment to the City of Boerne and the City would write the final check to the artist. Even though the payment includes charitable contributions, since the total purchase price is over the threshold required by City Charter, the purchase must be approved by City Council.</p> <p>The painting is currently on display at the Library and will be relocated to the new City Hall once construction is completed. A copy of the painting is attached for your reference.</p>
