SUMMARY	<p>Mark Mattick has been with the City of Boerne since 1993. He began his employment as a part time Fire Inspector. His salary at that time was \$200 per month plus \$10.00 for each inspection conducted. In 1995 he took on the duties of Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Coordinator. About four years later, his position became full time. In 2003, he not only was the Fire Marshal, responsible for fire inspections and EOC but also became responsible for City facilities.</p> <p>There are several thank you notes in Mark's file not only from businesses he helped with inspections, but also from school children he visited with regarding fire prevention, various organizations he assisted with training on AED's/CPR, and several others. These letters are an indication to Mark's immense dedication and service to our community.</p> <p>Mark's last day of employment with the City will be March 31, 2017.</p>
