<b>SUMMARY</b>	<p>In the FY 2016/2017 budget Council approved the purchase of a replacement for the current 1998 Command vehicle. The new vehicle will be equipped to function as a Command and / or First Responder unit for most medical incidents. Different types of vehicles were explored to serve this purpose, such as a pickup with a camper shell and roll out, a Chevrolet Tahoe, a Ford Expedition and a Suburban. After much thought and consideration, it was determined that a Suburban was the best fit for the current application. There will still be times that a pumper will respond to EMS incidents due to the nature and type of incident or available manpower. However, the intent is to utilize the smaller, more maneuverable vehicle most of the time, saving wear and tear on the larger, more expensive vehicles. We have received pricing from the Buy Board as well as local dealers, Cavender Chevrolet and Alamo City Chevrolet. Pricing found is as follows:</p> <p>Buy Board Caldwell County - \$43,920.00  Cavender Chevrolet - \$ 47,274.00  Alamo City Chevrolet - \$51,618.91</p> <p>Staff prefers to go with the local dealer, Cavender Chevrolet to support a local business. However, the Buy Board (Caldwell County) price is \$3,354.00 less, making it difficult to go with Cavender.</p>
