| <b>DESCRIPTION</b>                              | CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R41; A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE OLD SAN ANTONIO ROAD ELECTRICAL FEEDER PROJECT  |

| <b>SUMMARY</b>                                  | <p>The City has been performing various projects to complete the extension of four electric distribution feeders from the Menger Creek Substation on IH-10 and upgrade the four existing feeders from the Boerne Substation. Ultimately these projects will allow for increased distribution to handle overall load growth and enhance system reliability through supply redundancy.</p> <p>City personnel have performed various prior projects throughout the system, but it has become necessary to privatize the remaining construction in order to complete the work in a timely fashion. Only one larger scale project will remain after the completion of this current project, which is located along Old San Antonio Road, Oak Park and Herff/Essex (as highlighted in yellow on the attached map).</p> <p>We hired Schneider Engineering to design the project and put it out to public bid. Schneider's opinion of probable cost was \$169,710.19. Five electric distribution contractors picked up plans, and three of those firms submitted bids ranging from \$268,796.72 to \$341,961.86 (summary attached).</p> <p>It is now our choice to award the bid as presented or to reject all bids and re-advertise. On the basis of the relatively close bid amount spread, we believe that the actual value of the work in current construction conditions is exemplified in the bids submitted regardless of the engineer's estimated cost difference.</p> <p>Based on our experience with this type of work and the recommendation of Schneider engineering, it is Staff's recommendation that the project be awarded to the low bidder, Linetec Services, LLC at their bid amount of \$268,796.72.</p> |
