SUMMARY	The City of Boerne and Kendall County have held an interlocal agreement for Health Sanitarian services since 2000. The agreement details the responsibilities of the County to perform inspection services for all establishments or vendors that serve or provide food to the public.  Our fees last year for the services amount to \$49,132.00. The County added an employee to keep up with the number of locations that required inspection. We have an increase in the number of food establishments, day care centers, foster homes, and mobile units to warrant the additional employee. The cost for services for FY17-18 is \$56,430.50. Our cost does include the expectation of the County receiving \$52,655.00 in permit fees. These permit fees are used to offset the total cost to the City.  We will continue to monitor health inspections and the associated fees to the City. We are approaching the point, where the City may wish to take on this service as its own. This is an annual agreement and there is not a notification requirement for cancellation.
