SUMMARY	<p>On January 10, 2017, the City Council reviewed and approved the attached Legislative Plan. The Council took this action so that staff would understand the legislation that it deemed to be of the upmost importance to monitor due to the positive or negative affect it may have on our local government. In passing the Legislative Plan, Staff is able to act swiftly to proposed legislation which may affect the City of Boerne.</p> <p>With the Special Session starting on July 18, Staff believed it important to re-introduce the adopted 2017 Legislative Plan and to receive any new feedback you may have.</p> <p>We will also maintain close contact with the Texas Municipal League (TML) and their efforts with regard to the Special Session. City-related issues which may arise in the Special Session include revenue and spending caps, annexation reform, tree ordinance preemption, city permitting and cell phone/texting preemption. TML's stance is to keep power at the local level and not "centralize" it at a state level. I have included some updates from TML and will be attending their Legislative Wrap Up Session in Austin on June 30th and report back to you any new information.</p>
