| SUMMARY  | On January 10, 2017, the City Council reviewed and approved<br>the attached Legislative Plan. The Council took this action so<br>that staff would understand the legislation that it deemed to be<br>of the upmost importance to monitor due to the positive or<br>negative affect it may have on our local government. In passing<br>the Legislative Plan, Staff is able to act swiftly to proposed<br>legislation which may affect the City of Boerne.<br>With the Special Session starting on July 18, Staff believed it<br>important to re-introduce the adopted 2017 Legislative Plan and<br>to receive any new feedback you may have.<br>We will also maintain close contact with the Texas Municipal<br>League (TML) and their efforts with regard to the Special<br>Session. City-related issues which may arise in the Special<br>Session include revenue and spending caps, annexation reform,<br>tree ordinance preemption, city permitting and cell phone/texting<br>preemption. TML's stance is to keep power at the local level<br>and not "centralize" it at a state level. I have included some<br>updates from TML and will be attending their Legislative Wrap<br>Up Session in Austin on June 30 <sup>th</sup> and report back to you any<br>new information. |
