<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R70; A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND MANAGE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS AND KENDALL COUNTY FOR DETENTION SERVICES.
<b>STAFF'S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)</b>	Approve Resolution No. 2017-R70; A Resolution Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into And Manage An Interlocal Agreement Between The City Of Boerne, Texas And Kendall County For Detention Services.

<b>SUMMARY</b>	<p>The City of Boerne contracts with Kendall County to house prisoners that we arrest within our jurisdiction. The actual number of prisoners is calculated from May 1, 2016 to April 30, 2017 in determining our cost for the next fiscal year. If you notice the numbers in our annual report are different that is because they are based on calendar year, not contractual agreement time frame as per agreement.</p> <p>This past year we placed 683 prisoners into their facility.</p> <p>2008: 459 prisoners  2009: 423 prisoners  2010: 396 prisoners  2011: 428 prisoners  2012: 493 prisoners  2013: 516 prisoners  2014: 563 prisoners  2015: 559 prisoners  2016: 683 prisoners</p> <p>We did research surrounding counties that have similar agreements with cities and this agreement is similar in nature with those agreements. Once the prisoner is seen by a judge and magistrated they become prisoners of Kendall County.</p> <p>We have met with the county attorney to discuss various alternative methods in dealing with the increase in prisoners; however, the only agreement was methods to reduce their time within that facility. I do not support allowing specific misdemeanors such as; marihuana and other non-violent misdemeanors to be issued a citation/ ticket, commonly referred</p>

	to as field release rather than placing them in jail
