Mayor Schultz called the City Council to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Schultz asked for a Moment of Silence.

Mayor Schultz led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag and to the Texas Flag.

- 5. [2017-651](#) CONSIDER ON FIRST READING ORDINANCE NO. 2017-74; AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL CAPITAL AND OPERATING BUDGETS FOR THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018, BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018**

Mayor Schultz called on Ms. Sandy Mattick, Finance Director. Ms. Mattick reviewed the proposed changes to the FY 2018 Budget. She stated the proposed budget for FY 2018 is \$76,877,320 and displayed a break down of the budget for each Fund. The proposed tax rate will remain at \$0.4720. City Manager Ron Bowman discussed prioritizing streets that need to be striped. Discussion ensued regarding the budgeted amount to complete the Herff Road and connector bridge at Menger Creek. Mr. Bowman reminded the City Council that the tax rate has remained steady since 2012 when the bond election passed to increase the tax rate by \$0.06. The City however has only raised the tax by \$0.02 since that time. Ms. Mattick stated that the final vote on the

Budget will take place at the next regular City Council meeting scheduled for September 12, 2017.

**7. [2017-654](#) CONSIDER ORDINANCE NO. 2017-75; AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR NETWORK NODES AND NODE SUPPORT POLES IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF BOERNE.**

Mayor Schultz called on Ms. Kirsten Cohoon, City Attorney. Ms. Cohoon reminded the City Council of the previously discussed Senate Bill 1004 which passed in the 85th regular session of the legislature. The Bill requires a city to allow access for cellular antennae and related equipment in city rights-of-way and attach to city light poles, traffic poles, etc. The Design Manual which was included in the City Council's packet provides a caveat to allow for camouflage of the antennae within certain districts. Ms. Cohoon displayed a map of the city limits that includes the areas of the entrance corridor, the historic district, and

SoBo district. Staff recommended approval of Ordinance No. 2017-75.
