She reviewed the proposed changes stated the proposed budget for FY 2018 is \$76,877,320 and displayed a break down of the The proposed tax rate will remain budget for each Fund. at \$0.4720. City Manager Ron Bowman discussed prioritizing streets that need to be striped. Discussion ensued regarding the budgeted amount to complete the Herff Road and connector bridge at Menger Creek. Mr. Bowman reminded the City Council rate 2012 when that the tax has remained steady since the bond election passed to increase the tax rate by \$0.06. The City however has only raised the tax by \$0.02 since that time. Ms. Mattick stated that the final vote on the Budget will take place at the next regular City Council meeting scheduled for September 12, 2017.
