DESCRIPTION	CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R72; A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS PROVIDING THAT THE TERMS OF THE KENDALL APPRAISAL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS BE STAGGERED.
STAFF'S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)	Approve Resolution No. 2017-R72; A Resolution of the City of Boerne, Texas providing that the terms of the Kendall Appraisal District Board of Directors be staggered.

SUMMARY	<p>The Kendall Appraisal District (KCAD) Board of Directors approved a resolution requesting that the terms of the board of directors be staggered. There has been concern for some time because KCAD directors are elected or potentially replaced at the same time. With the proposed change, in odd numbered years four directors will be elected to serve a two year term beginning January 1, 2018. In even numbered years, three directors will be elected to serve a one year term beginning January 1, 2018. In 2018, the three directors position assigned to serve a one year term will be eligible for an appointment to a two year term in January 2019. If three-fourths of the taxing jurisdictions adopt a resolution approving staggered terms, then staggered terms will become effective.</p> <p>It is staff's recommendation to proceed with staggered terms for future appointments.</p>
