SUMMARY	The Texas Amateur Athletic Federation (TAAF) is a nonprofit organization established in 1925 to promote, organize and conduct amateur athletics in the state of Texas. TAAF consist of Parks and Recreation Departments across the state of Texas. Boerne Parks and Recreation has been a member of TAAF for 15 years. Each year TAAF selects a Member City of the Year and this award is the highest award given by TAAF to a member City. This is the third time Boerne Parks and Recreation has been awarded this honor (2010, 2012, and 2017). The award is given based on the overall representation of Boerne across the state. Danny Zincke, Community Services Director, has served for the past 15 years as the Youth Flag Football State Commissioner and currently serves as the TAAF President while Lissette Jimenez, Recreation Superintendent, currently serves as the Region 3 Director. Staff members volunteer for both the summer and winter Games of Texas each year and the department registered 326 teams across various sports. None of these things are possible without an amazing parks maintenance department keeping fields in shape and ready to play. The department also was only 1 of 3 cities in the state to receive the Platinum City award, our third in a row.
