SUMMARY	<p>In September, the City Council approved a resolution which provides for the Kendall Appraisal District Board of Directors terms to be staggered.</p> <p>It is now time to nominate a candidate to the Kendall Appraisal District Board of Directors. Each taxing unit may nominate a candidate.</p> <p>It is the recommendation of Mayor Schultz to nominate Mr. Jeff Haberstroh.</p> <p>The Kendall Appraisal District will prepare a ballot, listing candidates from each taxing unit. The City Council will be entitled to vote on the candidate at an upcoming City Council meeting.</p> <p>The term will begin January 2018 and will be a two-year term.</p>
