SUMMARY	Information technology placed \$56,000.00 in the FY 2017-2018 budget to replace our end-of-life hardware. There are three servers at the Police Department that are 5 years old and going out of warranty. They run the CAD software used by the City of Boerne, Fair Oaks Ranch, and Kendall County as well as being the file server for administrative and evidence files. We have recently begun to replace our Dell servers with Supermicro servers as they provide a better value for the money. I quoted out an equivalent Dell server and the price is \$14,200.21 more than the Supermicro servers from Thinkmate. The old servers will be repurposed at City Hall for spare parts until the City Hall servers are replaced in FY 2018-2019, and then auctioned off.
