<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2018-R03; A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF MAIN STREET (HWY 87) DURING CERTAIN HOURS FOR THE TEXAS CORVETTE ASSOCIATION SHOW AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATE RIGHT-OF-WAY WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
<b>STAFF'S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)</b>	Approve Resolution No. 2018-R03; Authorizing closure of a portion of Main Street for the Texas Corvette Association Show and authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement for the temporary closure with TxDOT.

<b>SUMMARY</b>	<p>The Texas Corvette Association has requested the closure of Main Street on April 21, 2018, for the parking of Corvette's that will be part of their annual car show. This will be the fifth year we have closed Main Street and allowed vehicles to park on the street, similar to the Rod Run event.</p> <p>The Texas Corvette Association has agreed to pay for barricades and other associated expenses with the road closure and we are supportive of this event.</p> <p>TxDOT requires a resolution from the City of Boerne as part of the road closure procedure for events which close Main Street for more than four hours. The request on closure time is 6:00am to 5:00pm. We will be closing the street down about 30 minutes earlier than last year which will allow officers to be better prepared when the participants start arriving.</p> <p>In addition, we will be leaving a lane open on West Blanco for vehicles to travel to those businesses that are in this area. We do require additional barricades for this type closure to assure that everyone is as safe as they can be.</p> <p>This event has a long standing relationship with the City of Boerne and brings in a lot of tourists as well as local traffic to the area. We are supportive of the event.</p>
