SUMMARY	The City of Boerne owns and maintains 11 emergency back-up generators used to keep critical operations up during times of power loss. Staff solicited quotes for the annual maintenance of those generators and received 3 bids. Cummins Southern Plains \$15,198.75, Waukesha-Pearce Industries \$17,850, and Kentech Inc. \$16,546. Funds are allocated in the 2017-2018 City of Boerne budget for this service.
