Minutes of the Special Called City Council meeting of May 10, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER AND WELCOME– 10:00 AM

Mayor Schultz called the City Council meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

Mr. Tommy Mathews, Chairman of the Boerne Kendall County Economic Development Corporation welcomed the audience to the new Boerne City Hall Groundbreaking.

2. PRESENTATION OF COLORS BY BOERNE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND BOERNE FIRE DEPARTMENT

Mr. Mathews asked for the audience to stand for the presentation of our Nation and State's colors, presented by members of the Boerne Police Department and the Boerne Fire Department.

Mr. Mathews introduced Ms. Erika Yount who sang the National Anthem and Mr. Mathews led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag.

Mr. Mathews introduced Jason Brown, Pastor of the nineteen:ten church to give the invocation.

Mr. Mathews introduced former City of Boerne Mayor Patrick Heath. Mr. Heath talked about his time in office. He stated with the public library on the same campus as the future city hall, will keep the City as a community undivided.

Mr. Mathews introduced Ms. Susie Allen, Chairman of the Boerne Chamber of Commerce. Ms. Allen congratulated past and present City Council Members for their diligence in this long planned and awaited achievement. Having a City Hall on the Main Street is a economic catalyst for a downtown district. The Chamber welcomes the new opportunity for economic development for downtown Main Street.

Mr. Mathews introduced City of Boerne Mayor Mike Schultz. Mayor Schultz stated it will be a glorious day in about 18 months when we get to cut the ribbon and open the doors to the new City Hall. The 15 acre parcel of land was purchased by the City in 2007 and in 2011 the library opened their doors. The current City Hall building was built in 1910 to serve as the first school in

Boerne. The City purchased the building in 1951. He spoke on the history of Boerne and the founding fathers. His wish to everyone in the audience is to keep the history alive in this community because it will sustain us as we go forward. Mayor Schultz expressed his appreciation to everyone in attendance witnessing this event. Mayor Schultz also expressed his appreciation to staff and especially Ms. Linda Zartler, Assistant City Manager for her contribution to the project.

Mayor Schultz asked the current City Council, City Staff, the Architect, the Project Manager, and the Construction Manager at Risk to joint him for the Groundbreaking/Shovel Turning.
