SUMMARY	In the FY 17/18 budget, Council approved the purchase of Thermal Imaging Cameras for the Fire Department. We will be purchasing two different models, allowing fire personnel to function as effectively as possible. One unit will be a small and lightweight breathing apparatus mask mount, with in mask display, allowing the firefighter a hands-free operation while fighting fire or performing a search. The other unit is a handheld unit that provides a larger screen with higher definition and zoom. The handheld unit also provides functions such as hot and cold spot tracking, high resolution imaging, tactical color image and automatic focus.
