SUMMARY	<p>In the FY 17/18 budget, Council approved the purchase of Thermal Imaging Cameras for the Fire Department.</p> <p>We will be purchasing two different models, allowing fire personnel to function as effectively as possible. One unit will be a small and lightweight breathing apparatus mask mount, with in mask display, allowing the firefighter a hands-free operation while fighting fire or performing a search. The other unit is a handheld unit that provides a larger screen with higher definition and zoom. The handheld unit also provides functions such as hot and cold spot tracking, high resolution imaging, tactical color image and automatic focus.</p>
