SUMMARY	<p>After 13 focus group meetings, multiple Technical Advisory Committee (City Staff) meetings, numerous key person interviews, 11 Master Plan Steering Committee meetings, an online survey that brought over 1,700 responses, three open houses and two joint meetings of the Steering Committee/ Planning and Zoning Commission/City Council. City Staff met and reviewed the document as a group. Each department has had an opportunity to review and comment. Council has provided feedback to Staff in two workshops. The document was provided to the community for review and those comments (as of July 5th) are attached for your review. Most of the public comments are in regard to the Kendall Gateway. To clarify, the Kendall Gateway is a separate Plan which has yet to be adopted by the County or the City of Boerne, but is reflected on the Future Land Use Plan to illustrate a future route around Boerne. The Planning and Zoning Commission is holding a public hearing July 9th to hear comments from the community. A report from the Commission will be provided to Council at the July 10th meeting.</p> <p>Staff is supportive of adopting the 2018 amended Comprehensive Master Plan.</p>
