SUMMARY	Attached is the proposed Interlocal agreement for fire protection to be provided by the Boerne Fire Department to the citizens of Kendall County who reside inside the Boerne Fire service area, but outside the corporate limits of the City of Boerne. (see exhibit A) The agreement also identifies liability and insurance responsibilities for apparatus and equipment. (see exhibits B and C) The only adjustments to the FY 18/19 agreement include a 3-year term, with a cost per rooftop set at \$42.50. In previous years the agreement consisted of a 1-year term, with costs being recalculated each year. The total dollar amount Kendall County will provide for FY 18/19 is
	\$446,420, up from \$418,756 in FY 17/18.
