SUMMARY	We recently received communication from TxDOT requesting that the City pass an ordinance establishing a 25 MPH Special Speed School Zone on FM-474. TxDOT has reportedly performed an engineering study to determine the need to establish the zone. Rather than having the required directive to establish an enforceable school zone passed at the Highway Commission level, TxDOT requested that the City pass an ordinance at the local level to implement their change. City Staff is in support of the modification as we understand the intent is to enhance safety in the area of the Boerne High School main campus entrance. It is our understanding the necessary regulatory signage will be installed by TxDOT.
