SUMMARY	Council has taken various prior actions regarding utility modifications associated with numerous ongoing TxDOT roadway improvement projects. The action being proposed is the execution of TxDOT's agreement for reimbursing the City for expenses associated with project management, design and construction to relocate City natural gas facilities within TxDOT right-of-way that have been deemed in conflict with TxDOT's proposed work. The area of concern and the location of the proposed work is shown on the attached map. Because this work is in Federal ROW (IH-10) TxDOT reimburses 100 percent of our costs. Under the proposed agreement, the City will be reimbursed \$976,303.98 as shown in the proposed agreement (attached). Although the terms of the agreement are not negotiable, Staff concurs that the terms are acceptable and recommends the Council authorize approval.
