SUMMARY	Animal Services staff and volunteers take our sheltered dogs out twice daily in all types of weather. Our current structure does not give relief from the elements, including the heat of the day during the summer months. A new shade structure for the dog exercise yard at the City of Boerne Animal Shelter was included in the FY 2019 budget. It was requested that we obtain quotes for a project for a permanent shade structure in the yard to allow staff, volunteers, and sheltered dogs relief from the elements to allow for longer sessions outside. The quote from Shadepro gave us the most shade opportunity within the budget amount.
COST	TOTAL = \$15,800. Initial quote was given 7/17/18 and Shadepro has offered to honor that quote if agreement is made and proposal is signed and returned before 3/1/2019.
